

Il verbo <FARE> significa “to do or make”, AND è usato in **molte espressioni idiomatiche**:

fare colazione = to have breakfast	fare la colazione (preparare) = to make breakfast
fare pranzo (pranzare) = to have lunch	fare il pranzo (preparare) = to make lunch
fare cena (cenare) = to have supper	fare la cena (preparare) = to make supper

fare uno spuntino	to have a snack
fare una festa	to have a party
fare un sogno	to have a dream
fare un incubo	to have a nightmare

fare rumore	to be noisy {or} to make noise
fare schifo	to be disgusting; to be revolting; to be awful; to make one sick

fare ginnastica	to do (physical) exercises {or} to work out
fare i compiti	to do <i>one's</i> homework (<i>literally</i> : to do the assignments)

fare <u>delle</u> commissioni	to run <u>some</u> errands
fare una domanda	to ask a question
fare la fila	to stand in line {o} to make a line
fare male (a + qualcuno)	to hurt : mi fa male, it hurts (me)
fare un regalo	to give someone a present
fare la valigia	to pack <i>one's</i> suitcase sfare la valigia, to unpack

fare il bagno	to take a bath <i>o</i> to go for a swim (nuotare = to swim)
fare la doccia	to take a shower
fare una foto	to take a picture
fare una passeggiata	to take a walk or a stroll (passeggiare = to stroll)
fare una pausa	to take a break
fare un pisolino	to take a nap
fare una vacanza	to take a vacation
fare un viaggio	to take a trip
fare con calma	to take <i>one's</i> time

fare lo shopping	to go shopping
fare la spesa	to go grocery shopping; to do the daily shop
fare un giro	to go for a ride; to take a walk around (someplace); to tour
fare un giro in bici	to go for a bike ride
fare sci	to go skiing (sciare = to ski)
fare snowboard	to go snowboard (to snowboard)
fare sub	to go scuba diving (to scuba dive)
fare trekking	to go hiking (to hike)
fare windsurf	to go windsurfing (to windsurf)

fa bello	it's beautiful out	fa freddissimo	it's freezing
fa brutto	it's ugly out	fa caldissimo	it's really, really hot
